**Casa Madero  
Coahuila****White Wines****2 V 2012****88 2013-15*****Chenin Blanc 50% Chardonnay 50%****Tasted at the London International Wine Fair May 2013*

The nose is very crisp quite light but fragrant. There are lots of gooseberries in the middle with slightly richer grapefruit at the back.

**Rosé Wines****V Rosado 2012****89 2013-15*****Cabernet Sauvignon 100%****Tasted at the London International Wine Fair May 2013*

The mix of raspberry and red cherry is fresh and the start of the palate has the same freshness of flavour. Slightly richer strawberry gives a little more weight on the mid palate but the finish is light fragrant and very fresh.

**Red Wines****3V 2011****88 2013-17*****Cabernet Sauvignon Merlot Tempranillo***

There is a mix of fruits on the nose some bramble and some red cherry. The mid palate is sweeter with ripe cassis and black plum then towards the back the freshness takes over leaving the finish lighter.
