The nose is very floral and fragrant with a lovely peachy character. The mid palate has a complex mix peach and apricot with some greengage then at the back crisp citrus. The mix of fruits layers of flavour give a lovely complexity.

### Red Wines

- Cinsaut Cabernet Sauvignon "Terra Hutton" 2012** 89 2013-17  
*Tasted at LWTF May 2013*  
 The red fruited nose is fresh and fragrant and the palate is easy with a mix of red fruits some cassis and bramble all backed by hints of spice. Although quite light on the back palate the finish is fuller with flavours that linger.
- Cinsaut Cabernet Sauvignon "Terra Hutton" 2013** 89 2014-18  
*Tasted at the LWF June 2014*  
 There is a lot of cassis on the nose with black cherry richness but the palate is lighter with more of a red fruit influence. Fresh at the back and although black fruits dominate the finish they are light and fresh.
- Growers Selection Red Blend "The Chairman" 2012** 90 2013-16  
**Shiraz Mourvèdre Cinsaut**  
*Tasted at LWTF May 2013*  
 Black fruits are more in evidence on the nose and the palate starts with bramble and bilberry. The fruit feels sweet giving richness on the mid palate but towards the back the more fragrant fruits come through with black and white pepper spicing up the finish.
- Black Granite Shiraz 2012** 91 2013-17  
*Tasted at LWTF May 2013*  
 The nose is deep black fruited and spicy yet the fruit on the start of the palate is more red fruit in character with redcurrant refreshing the mid palate. Towards the back it is more profound with power and depth of flavour sweet fruited quite lush.
- The Capeman 2013** 92 2013-18  
**Carignan Barbera Mourvèdre**  
*Tasted at LWTF May 2013*  
*Tasted at the LWF June 2014* 92 2014=18  
 Fresh on the nose slightly herbal the palate has bramble some red fruits an attractive freshness. The mid palate has more depth a richer mix of fruits and although sweet at the back the finish has freshness.
- Chocoholic Pinotage 2012** 92 2013-18  
*Tasted at LWTF May 2013*

The nose has a leafy freshness and the black and red fruits on the start of the palate are backed by herbal freshness. The mid palate is fuller with lots of ripe flavours their richness though underpinned by some fresh red fruits that give a lighter racier finish.

**Chocoholic Pinotage 2013****92 2014-20***Tasted at the LWF June 2014*

The fruit is ripe the nose has depth and a rich mix of flavours. Black fruits dominate the start of the palate but mid palate has more of a red fruit character the fruit though still ripe and sweet. There is a fresher feel at the back some raspberry and bitter chocolate yet the finish has the depth with the richness of ripe fruit.

**Sparkling Wine****90***Tasted at De Grendel February 2008*

The nose has lots of character, sweet tropical fruit backed by some greengage. It is crisp but not hard, the fruit weight fills out the mid-palate and the mineral apple crispness gives lots of length.

*(It will be disgorged towards the end of 2008 or early 2009 and the dosage, the amount of sweet wine added to determine the style, decided at that time)*

**Sauvignon Blanc 2004****88***South Africa Tasting October 2005*

There is good fresh fruit showing on the nose, a mix of gooseberry and tropical fruits. It starts with freshness on the palate with sweetness coming through in the middle. The finish has a mix of flavours asparagus and gooseberry to the fore.

**Sauvignon Blanc 2005****89***South Africa Tasting October 2005*

The nose is flowery, fragrant with a mix of gooseberry and asparagus. There is a sweet feel to the palate with a fresh, zippy middle. There is a lot of fruit showing towards the finish which has both character and interest.

**Sauvignon Blanc 2007 Tijgerberg****93***Tasted at De Grendel February 2008*

The nose has an attractive fragrance, the crispness of the fruit highlighted by flint and mineral. The mix of white peach and tropical fruit lends more weight to the mid palate, a touch of citrus and apple refreshes the flavours and emphasises the attractive dryness on the finish.

**Sauvignon Blanc 2007 Koetshuis 95**

*Tasted at De Grendel February 2008*

The nose has powerful flavours lots of asparagus and green pea overlaid with white peach and passion fruit. It is rich on the palate, the mix of flavours is excitingly complex and the nervy acidity balances the richness giving the feeling of poise and elegance.

**Sauvignon Blanc 2008 93**

*Tasted at De Grendel February 2008*

The fresh lime and gooseberry that are very much in evidence on the nose give a lovely crispness. The freshness is well balanced by some tropical fruits giving more weight on the mid palate. Citrus and apple is there on the finish ensuring a racy crispness.

**Sauvignon Blanc 2012 92 2013-16**

*Tasted in Gosmore June 2013*

There is a lovely citrus crispness on the nose with a lime driven start to the palate. It fills out in the middle some tropical fruits and grapefruit then the lime cuts in refreshing the back palate and finish.

**Winifred 2007 94**

***Chardonnay Viognier Semillon***

*Tasted at De Grendel February 2008*

It has all the richness that comes with good Chardonnay underpinned by the lemon freshness of the Semillon. The nose is floral, fragrant and this comes through on the palate, a charming mix of apricot and yellow peach. Time in oak has added breadth, a richness so well balanced by lemon curd freshness.

***Cabernet Sauvignon Cabernet Franc Pinotage***

*Tasted at De Grendel February 2008*

Onion skin in colour, the nose has forest fruits, wild strawberry and raspberry. The sweetness at the start of the palate is refreshed by some cherry backed by citrus. A wine that suits many food flavours or is great just for sipping

**Rosé 2008 90**

***Cabernet Sauvignon Cabernet Franc Pinotage***

*Tasted at De Grendel February 2008*

The floral mix of raspberry and redcurrant is racy and fresh. The fruit has sweetness and this gives some weight on the mid palate. Lovely mineral freshness comes out towards the back giving attractive crispness to the finish

### Red Wines

#### **Pinot Noir 2006 Op Die Berg**

**90**

*Tasted at De Grendel February 2008*

The richness of black plum is there on the nose and fleshes out the palate, behind is mulberry and red cherry, the freshness balancing the lush fruit. There is a slight lack of length, the feeling of young vines which time will cure.

#### **Merlot 2004**

**87**

*South Africa Tasting October 2005*

The nose is very light quite fragrant and flowery with some richer black plum in the background. The palate has sweet fruit but the middle lacks a bit of substance. There is fair length but quite it goes quite light on the finish.

#### **Merlot 2006**

**92**

*Tasted at De Grendel February 2008*

The nose is packed with black plum fleshed out by squashy strawberry. The sweetness is not overpowering as behind there are red fruits, hints of cherry and mulberry giving brightness to the flavours. The richness of the fruit fleshes out the finish.

#### **Shiraz 2004**

**89**

*South Africa Tasting October 2005*

There are a lot of ripe peppery red fruits on the nose. It is round and fleshy on the palate with a mix of mulberry, loganberry and some bramble. The tannins are ripe and there is an attractive weight of fruit on the finish.

#### **Shiraz 2005**

**93**

*Tasted at De Grendel February 2008*

The mix of mulberry and loganberry is fleshed out by some bramble and spiced up by a touch of black pepper. The ripeness of the tannins ensures richness on the mid palate enhanced by the fruit weight. Spicy red fruit is in evidence which lightens and refreshes leaving the finish bright and long.

#### **Shiraz 2006**

**94**

*Shiraz – small % + Viognier & Mourvèdre*

*Tasted at De Grendel February 2008*

The nose is concentrated, the fruit mix ripe, juicy and fleshy. Bramble and bilberry underpinned by mulberry and spiced up by white pepper ensure an exciting complexity, vigour towards the

back. Despite the power of the fruits there is a feel of elegance and lovely length of flavour. It is approachable this year but 2009 would be better and there is no hurry it will last.

**Shiraz 2011** 93 2013-18

*Tasted in Gosmore June 2013*

The mix of red and black fruits is concentrated juicy with the sweetness giving a fleshy richness on the start of the palate. There is red fruited freshness with some peppery spice under the sweet fruit bilberry and redcurrant but it fills out towards the back with the sweeter black fruits dominating.

**Shiraz 2013** 91 2016-23

*Tasted in Gosmore April 2016*

Concentrated black fruits the nose has richness the palate power black cherry and cassis. Fresher in the middle firm tannins the fruit underpinned by black pepper spice the finish has concentration and depth.

**Rubaiyat 2006** 94

***Cabernet Sauvignon Cabernet Franc Merlot Malbec***

*Tasted at De Grendel February 2008*

It is very black fruited on the nose, cassis then bilberry with hints of sloe and black truffle. The palate is structured, the tannins are firm but ripe so there is nothing aggressive or drying. Concentrated and complex the fruit has a dark chocolate richness invigorated by a touch of green pepper and the hint of oak.

Omar Khayyám's poetry was written in quatrains, fascinating verses of four lines.

De Grendel's Rubáiyát uses a "quatrain" of Bordeaux grapes to produce satisfying richness and exciting complexity.

*Tasted at Mosimann's July 2010*

*Tasted at The Lord Mayor's Banquet Guildhall November 2010*

The nose has depth of fruit rich apricot and greengage underpinned by some fresher lime. There is richness of flavour on the palate, round and fleshy yet well balanced by acidity. The layers of flavour give complexity with the fruit mix lingering on the finish.

*Tasted at the Carlton Club May 2012*

The nose is remarkably light red fruited red plum more than black. The mid palate lacks weight of fruit a slight hollow and the fruit seems to be drying on the finish.

**Sweet White Wines****Edelspatz 2009****89 2010-16***Tasted at Mosimann's July 2010*

Peaches and apricots are very prominent on both nose and palate. It is sweet at the start with some fresher tropical fruits coming through on the mid palate, the sweetness taking over and enriching the finish.

There is a leafy herbal quality on the nose with a rich mix of flavours on the palate. Peach and apricot are backed by apple and lime freshness an attractive complex mix with the sweetness of the fruit filling out the back palate. The finish has a hint of spicy oak adding to the complexity.

**Maestro White 2013****92 2014-18****Roussanne Chenin Blanc Viognier Chardonnay***Tasted at the LWF June 2014*

Peach apricot on the nose the start of the palate has depth of flavour. It feels lighter in the middle leafy and citrusy but fills out at the back with fleshy white peach.

**DMZ Chenin 2012****90 2013-17***Tasted at Seckford Agencies tasting Vivat Bacchus London March 2013*

Tropical fruits feature on both nose and palate quite sweet and rich in the middle but towards the back it is fresher with more of a citrus character yet the finish has all the richness of white peach.

**DMZ Chenin Blanc 2013****90 2014-18***Tasted at the LWF June 2014*

Hints of peach on the nose quite sweet yet the palate starts fresher but has sweet fruit in the middle. Citrus refreshes the back palate and the finish is light with a mix of fragrances.

**Reserve Chenin 2012****91 2013-17**

*Tasted at Seckford Agencies tasting Vivat Bacchus London March 2013*

The nose has depth and breadth of flavour tropical fruits white peach lovely ripe fruit. The fleshy richness is balanced by freshness in the middle with the richer fruit filling out the finish.

**Chenin Blanc Reserve 2013** 92 2014-18

*Tasted at the LWF June 2014*

The fruit is sweet ripe peach apricot richness and although the palate is rich the freshness at the back refreshes and lightens the finish.

**DMZ Sauvignon Blanc 2012** 90 2013-16

*Tasted at Seckford Agencies tasting Vivat Bacchus London March 2013*

The tropical fruits on the nose are backed by fresher flavours a citrus and apple mix. The freshness on the mid palate brings out the fragrances spring flowers and although the finish is light and crisp there is a hint of tropical fruit sweetness at the back.

**DMZ Chardonnay 2012** 91 2013-17

*Tasted at Seckford Agencies tasting Vivat Bacchus London March 2013*

Crisp apple refreshes the nose and the start of the palate but there is sweetness the richness of melon and greengage on the mid palate. Towards the back the fresher flavours dominate with a lovely citrus and apple mix on the finish.

**DMZ Chardonnay 2013** 91 2014-19

*Tasted at the LWF June 2014*

The nose has some rich fruit the palate full with ripe greengage all balanced by apple at the back. The finish has a mix of flavours citric freshness with greengage melon fleshiness.

**Syrah Grenache Mourvèdre***Tasted at Seckford Agencies tasting Vivat Bacchus London March 2013*

The richness of ripe strawberries fills out the nose and the start of the palate has sweetness and depth of flavour. Behind redcurrant and raspberry refresh and give a lighter feel to the finish.

**Syrah Mourvèdre Grenache***Tasted at the LWF June 2014*

Light fragrant red fruited the nose is fresh and the start of the palate has a mix of red fruits underpinned by herbal leafiness. The finish is fragrant and fresh fruited.

**Merlot Cabernet Sauvignon Petit Verdot Malbec Cabernet Franc***Tasted at Seckford Agencies tasting Vivat Bacchus London March 2013*

The nose has lots of different flavours with rich cassis to fresh bilberry and the palate is as complex with layers of flavour. The fruit is ripe the palate supple fleshy with liquorice and chocolate but towards the back there is enough freshness to balance with some leafy and herbal bramble.

**DMZ Syrah 2011****92 2013-18***Tasted at Seckford Agencies tasting Vivat Bacchus London March 2013*

The nose is vibrant fresh with a mix of red fruits and the start of the palate has a peppery freshness. There is a sweetness to the fruit on the mid palate layers of flavour with the sweeter fruit enriching back palate and finish.

There is a lot of fresh greengage on the nose and although this seems to dominate the start of the palate underneath is ripe sweet honeydew melon. There a lovely balance between freshness and richness with the crispness of apple coming through and giving a lovely freshness on the finish.

The mix of blackberry and black cherry has an underlying richness and the mid palate is full of ripe flavours but towards the back there is a bit of red fruit freshness with some black pepper on the finish.

Fresh greengage is supported by sweeter honeydew melon. The palate feels ripe fleshy succulent flavours underpinned by toasty oak. The fleshy ripe fruit is well integrated with vanilla and hazelnut all adding to the complexity.

*Tasted at Doolhof February 2008*

The fragrant greengage fruit is backed by some lime giving freshness on the start of the palate. Sweeter melon fleshes out the mid palate but there is citrus underpinning giving brightness on the finish.

**Sauvignon Blanc 2007****88***Tasted at Doolhof February 2008*

Nettles and minerals overlay the mix of pear and tropical fruit. The palate is sweet at the start, the acidity of the citrus fruits refreshes the mid palate and leaving the finish flinty crisp.

**Red Wines****Cape Roan 2006****89*****Shiraz Malbec Cabernet Sauvignon Merlot****Tasted at Doolhof February 2008*

A fascinating mix of flavours, the red fruit and peppery spice of Shiraz is very much in evidence with behind and supporting it some fleshy black plum and ripe cassis. Towards the back are hints of black truffles, leathery spice coming out on the finish.

**Cape Boar 2004****88*****Cabernet Sauvignon Cabernet Franc Shiraz****Tasted at Doolhof February 2008*

The powerful black fruits on the nose are very dominated by blackcurrant with underneath some fresher bilberry, herbal spice and hints of red fruits. The palate has depth, layered fruit, complexity but it is rather dominated by aggressive tannins.

**Cabernet Sauvignon 2005****89***Tasted at Doolhof February 2008*

The nose is packed with blackcurrants, rich and ripe. Rounded tannins help to flesh out the palate, lots of dark chocolate adding to the sweetness. There is a touch of peppery spice, not surprising with some Shiraz in the blend.

**Merlot 2005****89***Tasted at Doolhof February 2008*

Smoky black plum fleshes out the nose and gives lushness on the palate. The ripeness of the fruit combined with rounded tannins ensures fleshy richness on the mid palate and depth of fruit on the finish.

**Pinotage 2006****87***Tasted at Doolhof February 2008*

The fruit on the nose is ripe, quite fleshy and lush with more red fruits, strawberry and mulberry, in evidence than black. On the palate the richness is well balanced by freshness, lots of raspberry fruit. It is just a touch short on the finish.

The nose is remarkably sweet fruited giving richness on both nose and palate. Some red fruits show towards the back refreshing and giving a lighter feel to the finish.

The nose is very rich with cassis as the predominant flavour. There is sweetness and depth of fruit on the palate, spice plum and mulberry with some truffle chocolate. There is layered complexity and excellent length, enjoyable now but will benefit from another twelve months or so in bottle.

It is very floral with fragrant spring blossoms under which is fresh lime and lemon. Sweeter peach gives some weight on the mid palate but towards the back the citrus mix tends to dominate giving a lovely freshness on the finish.

**Big Easy Chenin 2011****90****2012-15***Tasted at the London Wine Trade Fair May 2012*

The nose is tropical fruit driven quite sweet and the ripe mix of flavours fills out the start of the palate. There is mid freshness a touch of grapefruit and this gives a lighter feel on the finish.

**Big Easy Chenin 2012****90****2013-16***Tasted at Seckford Agencies tasting Vivat Bacchus London March 2013*

There is a lot happening on the nose apple and grapefruit freshness with hints of spice and a touch of oak. There is some sweetness on the mid palate but the overall feel is one of freshness of green limes, herbal and leafy.

**Big Easy Chenin Blanc 2013****91****2013-16***Tasted at the Leathersellers November 2013*

Tropical fruits give sweetness the apple and citrus freshness. The ripe flavours fill out the mid palate quite lush and rich but towards the back its fresher leafy herbal and racy with a good long finish.

**Sauvignon Blanc 2011****91****2011-14**

*Tasted at the Wines of South Africa tasting October 2011*

The nose is sweet with a lovely tropical fruit character. Freshness comes through on the palate with the mix of sweeter fruits underpinned by citrus and a touch of gooseberry. There is a lovely mix of flavours towards the back and the fruit ripeness gives flesh on the finish.

**Sauvignon Blanc 2013****91 2013-16***Tasted at the Royal College of Physicians November 2013*

Under the tropical fruits the citrus mix is racy and fresh a lovely balance. Layers of fruit give complexity the richer flavours towards the back giving way to lime and lemon lifting the flavours on the finish.

**Red Wines****Big Easy Red 2009****93 2011-17*****Shiraz Cabernet Sauvignon Grenache Mourvèdre Viognier****Tasted at Vinopolis October 2010*

The fruit is very ripe but not over fleshy as under the ripe cassis are red fruits and herbal freshness. Rounded tannins help to ensure fleshiness on the mid palate and a lush ripe fruited finish. The name sums up the suppleness of the palate.

**Big Easy Red 2010****90 2011-14*****Shiraz Cabernet Sauvignon Grenache Mourvèdre Viognier****Tasted at the London Wine Trade Fair May 2011*

There is an attractive freshness on the nose all very red fruit in character. Under the raspberry is richer red cherry and then towards the back more black fruits the sweetness giving a fleshy richness. The finish has the red fruit freshness found on the nose lovely and bright.

**Chardonnay 2004****88***South Africa Tasting October 2005*

It feels very light on the nose although it has fragrance and a floral character. There is freshness at the start of the palate with ripe, sweet fruit showing on the middle. The finish is just a touch short.

**Chardonnay Reserve 2004****90***South Africa Tasting October 2005*

Although there is a good weight of fruit on the nose floral fragrances do show themselves. The palate has good depth with a mix of lemon, melon and greengage. There are hints of oak but it does not dominate and the finish has a good length of flavour.

The nose is very light but quite fragrant. Sweet and leafy on the palate there is a mix of cassis and black plum giving a richer feel towards the back. Sweetness of fruit comes through on the finish.

**Pinot Noir 2004****89***South Africa Tasting October 2005*

The nose has lots of interest with a mix of black cherry and mulberry all quite fragrant yet sweet. There is good depth with supple flavours and an attractive length of fruit.

**Syrah 2004** **88**

*South Africa Tasting October 2005*

There is a lot of ripe peppery red fruit on the nose. It feels quite sweet at the start of the palate but then firmer in the middle and the finish is very tight at the moment.

**Cabernet Sauvignon 2007** **92**    **2011-17**

*Tasted in Bulawayo Zimbabwe August 2011*

The nose is very cassis driven and the sweetness of the fruit fills out the mid palate further enriched by liquorice and dark chocolate. Under all of the powerful fruit there is the freshness bilberry and bramble that gives a slightly lighter more elegant feel on the finish.

**Cabernet Sauvignon 51% Merlot 41% Cabernet Franc 3% Malbec 4% Petit Verdot 1%**

*South Africa Tasting October 2005*

The fruit on the nose is rich with a mix of blackcurrant and green peppery black plum. It has good weight of fruit in the middle and a complex mix of flavours showing towards the back. The fruit lasts well.

### Glenelly Stellenbosch

This beautiful estate lies in the Idas Valley on the southern slopes of the Simonsberg Mountain with origins dating back to the 17<sup>th</sup> century when the Governor of the Cape, Simon van der Stel, gave land to the French Huguenot Francois Villion. Today it is owned by May de Lencquesaing of Château Pichon Longueville Comtesse de Lalande fame so no wonder the style has a hint of "claret" about it.

There is a lot of fresh fruit showing on the nose with apple and greengage vying for dominance. The sweetness of ripe fruit gives more depth to the mid palate but this richness is nicely balanced by the apple acidity that is there underpinning and giving freshness on the finish.

**Glass Collection Chardonnay 2011** **92**    **2011-15**

*Tasted at the London Wine Trade Fair May 2011*

The mix of greengage and melon is rich and powerful packing out the nose and giving sweetness to the palate. Lime and apple underpin refreshing and lifting the flavours towards the back and balancing the fleshy power.

 The sweetness of ripe fruit gives a fleshy richness on the nose and depth of flavour on the palate. Behind the ripe melon lime and apple refresh and give a slightly lighter feel to the finish.

 The impression is one of tropical fruit sweet and ripe at the start the fruit backed by citric firmness a lack of real balance the finish aha hint of pear drops.

*Tasted at the SITT tasting London February 2015*

 Light with lime and apple the nose has an attractive freshness and the start of the palate is crisp. Greengage gives more depth in the middle but the rich fruit is underpinned by citrus freshness that lightens the finish.
- Estate Chardonnay 2016** 90 2018-21  
*Tasted in the Mansion House June 2018*  
 Ripe fruit the nose has a rich mix of ripe fruits the palate is fleshy with ripe melon. There is a balancing apple freshness an underlying streak of citrus but it finishes sweet ripe and fleshy.
- Grand Vin White 2010** 93 2011-15  
*Tasted at the London Wine Trade Fair May 2011*  
 It is a big wine with lots of powerful flavours on the nose and the richness of pineapple on the palate. The depth of fruit enriches mid and back palate but there is some freshness helping to balance and give a slightly lighter feel on the finish.
- Grand Vin Chardonnay 2011** 92 2012-16  
*Tasted at the London Wine Trade Fair May 2012*  
 The fruit is ripe giving lots of richness on the nose and fleshy sweetness on the palate. There is some cut apple that helps to balance the richness and the spice of the oak features on the finish.

*Tasted at the LWF June 2014*  
 Rich on the nose the palate has melon and greengage fleshiness. There is mid freshness apple under the rich fruit but the fruit ripeness sweetness gives weight on the finish.

*Tasted at the LWF June 2014*  
*Tasted at the SITT tasting London February 2015*

*Tasted at the Lea & Sandeman tasting Galleria London March 2015*

Apple and citrus refresh greengage and melon enrich a lovely mix of flavours the layers of fruit on the palate giving complexity. The rich ripe sweet flavours are balanced by freshness slightly lighter at the back yet there is fruit power a nice depth of flavour on the finish.

**Red Wines****Glass Collection Cabernet Sauvignon 2008****91 2010-15***Tasted at Innholders May 2010*

There is a lovely richness to the nose, sweet ripe cassis and black cherry. The black fruited mix is there on the palate, layers of flavour giving complexity, the fruit feeling ripe. Underpinning there are some firm tannins that give structure but they are rounded with nothing aggressive about them allowing the fruit to flesh out the finish.

**Glass Collection Cabernet Sauvignon 2009****91 2011-16***Tasted at Lincoln's Inn November 2011*

The cassis on the nose has an underlying herbal character with a touch of spice right at the back. The tannins are firm the mid palate tight but there is sweet cassis showing towards the back nicely balanced by fresher bramble and bilberry.

The fruit on the nose is ripe a mix of sweet cassis and black cherry. The ripe flavours give a fleshy richness on the palate the black fruits backed by liquorice and chocolate and this powerful mix fills out the back palate.

**Glass Collection Cabernet Sauvignon 2011****92 2014-20***Tasted at the LWF June 2014*

Fresh on the nose there is a mix of blackcurrant and bramble on the start of the palate. Ripe fruit gives depth and sweetness in the middle the fruit enriched by liquorice but at the back it feels fresher lighter on the finish.

**Glass Collection Cabernet Sauvignon 2012****91 2015-20***Tasted at the SITT tasting London February 2015*

Cassis rich on the nose with a depth of black fruits on the palate the fruit is ripe and the tannins supple. Firmer at the back more of a black cherry character and the finish is lighter and quite fresh.

**Glass Collection Cabernet Franc 2016****87 2018-22***Tasted in the Mansion House June 2018*

The fruit on the nose is herbal and fresh the palate firm with tight tannins. Bramble and bilberry at the back gives a little more depth slighter richer but it dries on the finish a touch dusty.

**Glass Collection Merlot 2009****90 2010-14***Tasted at Innholders May 2010*

It is very Merlot on the nose with lots of ripe fleshy black plum in evidence. The palate is rich with some ripe fruit yet behind is the freshness of red cherries giving a lighter feel towards the back. The sweetness of the fruit shows well on the long finish.

**Glass Collection Merlot 2010****92 2013-18***Tasted at LWTF May 2013*

The nose is rich with lots of ripe black fruits. Black plum enriches the mid palate voluptuous, fleshy and supple lots of sweet flavours. There is enough black cherry freshness to balance and give a lighter less sumptuous feel on the finish.

Ripe fruited on the nose there is black plum richness on the palate. The sweetness of the fruit is balanced some mid freshness but it fills out at the back supple rich and fleshy on the finish.

The fruit on the nose is sweet ripe the start of the palate fleshy the mid palate has plum stone firmness. The sweet fruit tends to slide the finish is a bit dry.

There is a very attractive spice perfume on the nose black fruits backed by red fruits with mulberry to the fore. The sweetness of the fruit gives flesh on the mid palate black cherry vying with bramble for dominance. A touch of spice pepper brightens the back palate giving lots of interest to the finish.

The fruit feels ripe sweet a mix of red fruits. Although the palate starts sweet with rich flavours there is an underlying freshness some red cherry that balances and brings out black pepper spiciness. The finish has the richness of ripe fruit.

 Although both nose and palate are very sweet fruited there is nothing jammy as there are bright flavours underpinning and balancing. The layers of fruit add to the complexity with towards the back dark chocolate and liquorice enriching. The finish has an attractive herbal spicy twist.

***Cabernet Sauvignon Petit Verdot***

 The nose is deep and brooding packed with rich cassis backed by fresher bramble. Ripe fruit gives a fleshy richness to the mid palate black fruits and dark chocolate. Towards the back there is freshness and the fruit has a slightly herbal edge.

Deep brooding black fruited there are a lot of powerful flavours on the nose with rich ripe cassis and black cherry on the palate. The tannins are firm but ripe there is structure at the back but lots of sweet fruit on the back palate.

 With such a high percentage of Cabernet one would expect the flavours to be Cabernet dominated, not so, although there is lots of cassis it is intermingled with some leafy red fruits. Easy fresh, it is wonderful just as a glass of wine or as a partner to both fish and lighter meat dishes.

*Tasted at Seckford Agencies October 2004*  
 There is a lot happening on the nose, peppery plum and mulberry. There is depth of fruit on the palate and the fruit has the excitement of black pepper and spice. Fair length needs a bit more time in bottle.

**Shiraz 2004** **90**  
*South Africa Tasting October 2005*  
 It is very fragrant with spicy red berried fruits on the nose. Pepper and spice on the palate underpinned by a mix of flavours, mulberry, loganberry and a touch of bramble. The fruit feels ripe giving sweetness on the powerful deep finish.

**Shiraz 2005** **90**  
*Tasted at Seckford Agencies October 2006*  
 There is a lovely sweetness to the nose, an attractive mix of red fruits underpinned by bramble. The black pepper on both nose and palate gives spiciness to the fruit, all helping the complexity. The sweet quite fleshy black fruits are refreshed by the acidity from the mulberry.

**Shiraz 2007** **90**

*Tasted at Seckford Agencies October 2008*

Punchy and sweet on the nose, a peppery spice backs the dominant black fruits giving lots of excitement. The start of the palate is rich and sweet lots of bramble and bilberry but there is freshness coming from the red cherry that lies beneath. The finish has power yet is given a racy feel by the cracked black pepper.

**Shiraz 2008****92***Tasted at Seckford Agencies October 2009*

The nose is lovely and rich packed with sweet black fruits. The mix of bramble, black plum and black cherry is fleshed out by dark chocolate spiced up with a touch of black pepper on the finish.

**Shiraz 2009****91 2011-17***Tasted at Vinopolis October 2010*

Rich spicy peppery black fruits show on the nose and give lots of character on the palate. The bramble and black cherry mix is given an added richness by the rounded tannins but towards the back there is a fresher feel from some red cherry.

*Tasted in Bulawayo Zimbabwe August 2011***91 2011-17**

The nose has a lovely spicy character all very black fruited with the black cherry intermingling with bramble. The mid palate is sweet the fruit feeling ripe but towards the back there is enough freshness, black pepper and spice to brighten the finish.

Black plums and yet more black plums. The nose is very rich and full of ripe flavours. Depth and weight on the palate, it has an opulence but is perhaps a touch one dimensional. There is real weight of fruit on the finish.

**Merlot 2004****88***South Africa Tasting October 2005*

There is a lot of fruit showing on the nose, opulent ripe plum. The palate has a sweetness of flavour but the fruit is still quite tight and the tannins quite structured. Black and red plum is there on the finish and although quite rich there is the feel of more to show with time.

**Merlot 2006****89***Tasted at Seckford Agencies October 2008*

There is a good weight of black plum on the nose with behind it a fragrant herbal freshness. The palate is fleshy, packed with black plums, the ripe rounded tannins all adding to the lushness. Right at the back the herbal freshness pushes through ensuring brightness on the finish.

**Merlot 2007****92***Tasted at Seckford Agencies October 2009*

The nose is big, fat and fleshy lots of ripe plum. The sweetness of fruit is there on the palate enriching the middle and filling out the back palate. Under this supple lushness there are some red fruits that lift the flavours and ensure brightness on the finish.

*Tasted in Lilley December 2009*

Rich and ripe the black plum fleshes out the nose and gives richness on the start of the palate. The ripe black plum is lightened and refreshed by bilberry and bramble all adding to the complexity. The sweetness of the fruit is there on the back palate giving flesh to the finish.

**Merlot 2009** **91**    **2011-16**

*Tasted at Vinopolis October 2010*

The nose is strongly plum with a mix of red and black. The fruit is ripe giving fleshiness at the start and enriching the mid palate. Towards the back there are fresher influences with lots of red cherry in evidence. The fruit lasts well on the finish.

**Merlot 2013** **90**    **2015-20**

*Tasted at the SITT tasting London February 2015*

Rich black plum on the nose the palate is fleshy with ripe fruits. Chocolate rich in the middle the tannins are rounded the back palate full of richness. Slightly lighter on the finish the black plum backed by some bramble.

**Malbec Tannat 2008** **94**    **2011-18**

*Tasted at the Wines of South Africa tasting October 2011*

The South African sun ensures that the Tannat is ripe and the more red fruit character marries well with the black truffle of the Malbec. There are some powerful flavours on the start of the palate but in the middle red fruit freshness gives a lighter feel and brings out the complex flavour mix on the finish.

***Cabernet Sauvignon Shiraz Merlot***

*Tasted at Seckford Agencies October 2004*

Sweet ripe and fat, very cassis dominated on nose. The palate although fat and full has some complexity and interest, the mix of spice plum and blackcurrant gives excitement and the flavours linger well.

*South Africa Tasting October 2005*

The nose is light with freshness and fragrance spicy peppery plum and blackcurrant. The taste has sweetness, a ripe feel to the fruit making for a supple, rounded mouthful. It is a wine with a very attractive fragrance and lightness and has flavours that linger.

**Frontier 2009** **92**    **2010-15**

**Cabernet Sauvignon Shiraz Merlot***Tasted at Vinopolis October 2010*

The upfront red fruits give a lighter fresher feel on the nose but on the palate the underlying black fruits come through and take over fleshing it out. Towards the back there are hints of spice and black pepper all helping complexity. The finish is full, rounded and fleshy.

**SMG 2002****87****Syrah Mourvèdre Grenache***Tasted at Seckford Agencies October 2004*

This mix of southern Rhone grapes has an enticing spice pepper character. The palate although showing sweet ripe fruit is lighter and the finish is not overpoweringly heavy.

**SMG 2003****89****Shiraz Mourvedre Grenache***South Africa Tasting October 2005*

It is sweet and juicy on nose with leafy spicy red berried fruits. There is freshness at the start of the palate with a supple ripeness fleshing out the middle. The mouth feel is of rounded softness with lots of mulberry and leafy peppery spice. There is a good length of fragrant fruit

**SMG 2009****91****2011-16****Shiraz Mourvèdre Grenache***Tasted at the Wines of South Africa tasting October 2011*

The mainly red fruits on the nose are backed by herbal freshness but as the fruit feels ripe the palate has fleshy richness. The mid sweetness and weight gives way to fresher lighter red fruit flavours and the finish has a peppery herbal raciness.

**Lapa Cabernet 2005****91***Tasted at Seckford Agencies October 2006*

Packed with cassis, bilberry and sloe, there is a lot happening on the nose. The palate has richness; behind the fruit is dark chocolate sweetness fleshing out the mid palate. The balance between sweetness and freshness is excellent with a rich but quite elegant feel to the finish.

**Lapa Cabernet 2006****93***Tasted at Seckford Agencies October 2008*

There are lots of powerful fruit flavours filling out the nose. The richness promised on the nose is certainly there on the palate with a mass of blackcurrant and sloe fleshed out by dark chocolate and given a spice excitement but the hints of coffee. The richness of the fruit lends weight to the finish.

**Lapa Cabernet Sauvignon 2007****96***Tasted at Seckford Agencies October 2009*

Black cherry gives richness to the nose with behind it some fresher more fragrant bilberry. The fruit is ripe, rich and fleshy with black plum, blackcurrant and blackberry all vying for dominance

ensuring lots of complexity. The mid palate has ripe fruit power but towards the back there is some underlying mulberry and bilberry that refreshes and lightens the richness leaving the feeling of elegance.

**Lapa Cabernet Sauvignon 2008****94 2011-18***Tasted at Vinopolis October 2010*

There is a lot of generous fruit on the nose all very cassis dominated. Rich dark chocolate fleshed out the mid palate, rounded tannins adding to the suppleness. Sloe, black cherry and blackcurrant give a lovely complex mix of flavours on the powerful finish.

**Lapa Cabernet 2009****94 2014-25***Tasted at Mercers' Hall November 2011*

The nose has a lot of rich fruit quite fleshy and sweet fruited. The ripeness of the fruit fills out the mid palate rounded tannins and dark chocolate help to enrich with the cassis, black cherry and sloe given an added complexity by liquorice. There is a hint of oak on the finish giving a touch of spice.

**Stellenbosch 2009****93 2012-18****Jean Englebrecht*****Cabernet Sauvignon Malbec Merlot Petit Verdot****Tasted at the Wines of South Africa tasting October 2011*

The nose is rich full of ripe fruit with cassis and black cherry very much to the fore. Sweet ripe flavours fill out the mid palate and this combined with rounded tannins give suppleness but there is enough freshness enough structure from the Petit Verdot to balance and ensure the back palate is lighter and the finish has a more elegant feel.
